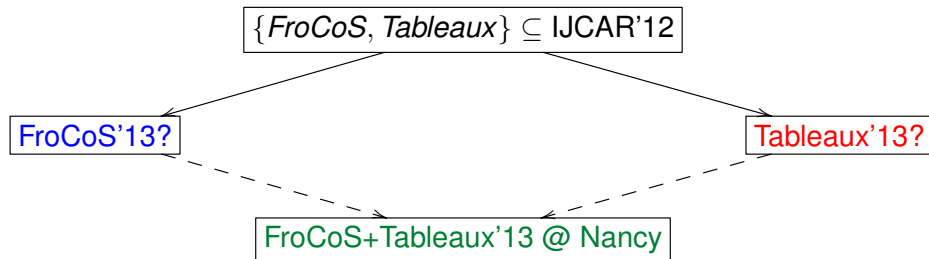

# Participation

Registration fees:

FroCoS only: 350 € (same as FroCoS'11)

Tableaux only: 400 € (including one workshop day)

Tableaux+FroCoS: 430 €

Late: +50 €, Student: -50 €

Number of participants: 94 (including 23 students)

- FroCoS only: 18
- Tableaux only: 18
- Tableaux workshops only: 8
- Tableaux+FroCoS: 50 (including 6 invited speakers)
